SUMMER DATES:

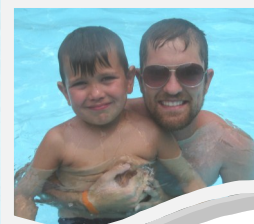

Unless there are major, extenuating circumstances, and an exception is made by the Administrator, Merriwood expects staff members to commit to the entire 11 week timeframe.

SALARY:

Working at Merriwood is a ministry position. Although we wish we could pay more, MCC pays \$165 a week plus room and board for the first-year, college-aged staff member. In addition to this, anyone coming to work for the summer is encouraged (although not required) to contact their church, friends, and relatives and ask them to: 1) Pray for you, and 2) Support you financially. Although not required, we suggest staff try to raise an additional \$165 per week. Once hired, MCC provides sample support letters to assist in this process.
