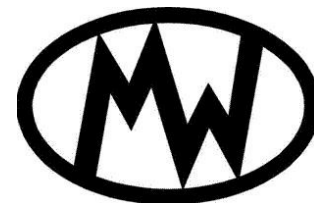


REMOTE LEARNING CAMP at MERRIWOOD
