



HEALTH SCREENING QUESTIONS SUMMER CAMP 2021

1. Have you had close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) in the last 14 days with someone diagnosed with COVID-19, or has any health department or health care provider been in contact with you and advised you to quarantine?

2. Do you have any of these symptoms?
 - Fever
 - Chills
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - New cough
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Ongoing, unexplained headache
 - Nausea, diarrhea

3. Have you been diagnosed with COVID-19? (gotten a positive within the last 14 days?)

Notes:

- If a camper does not pass the health screening, they will not be permitted to leave the vehicle.
- If a camper becomes symptomatic while at camp, they will be isolated and parents will be contacted to pick up their child. Campers will be sent home if they have unexplained and/or ongoing headache, fever of 100.4 or above, loss of taste or smell, vomiting, diarrhea, are unwell, or are exhibiting symptoms that could be contagious.
